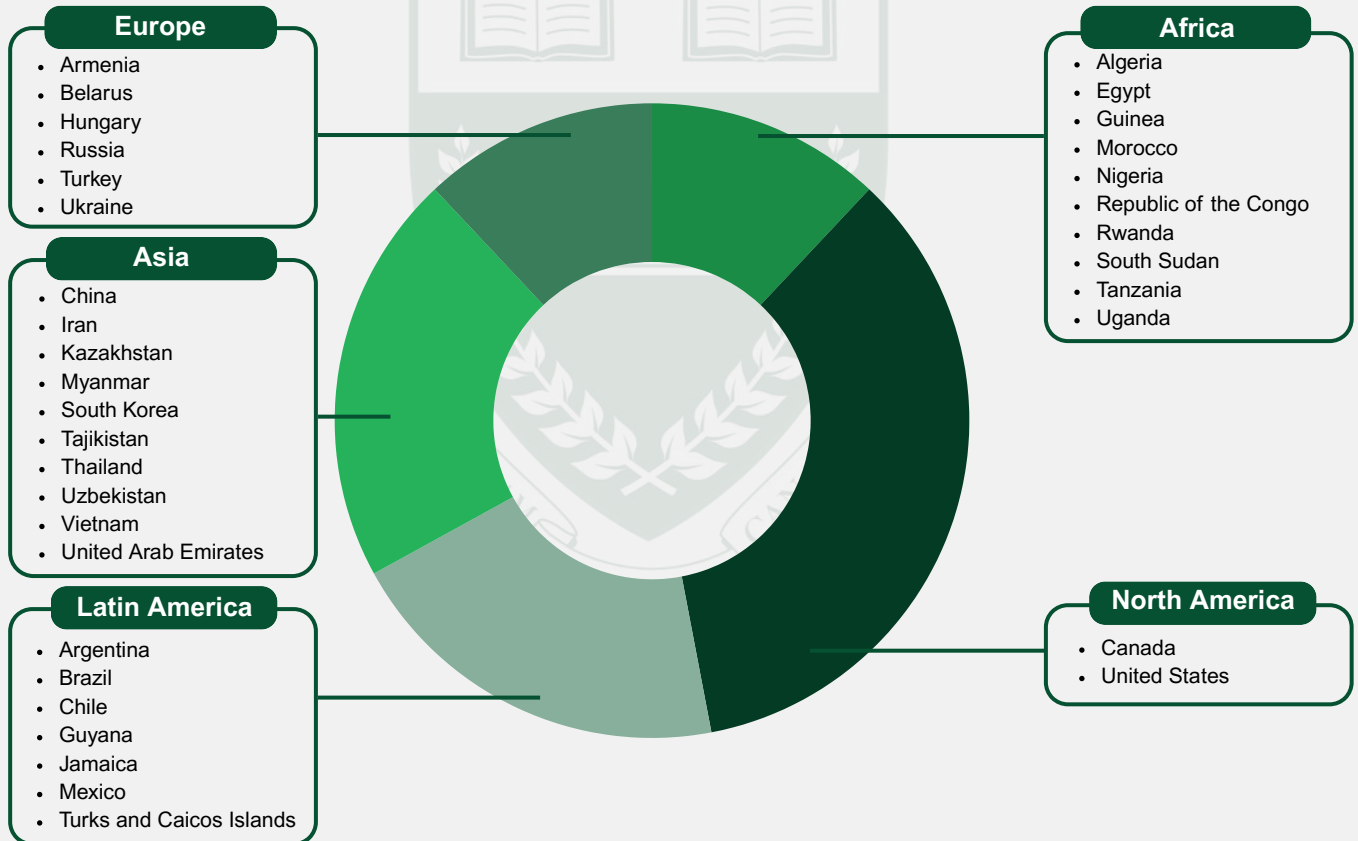

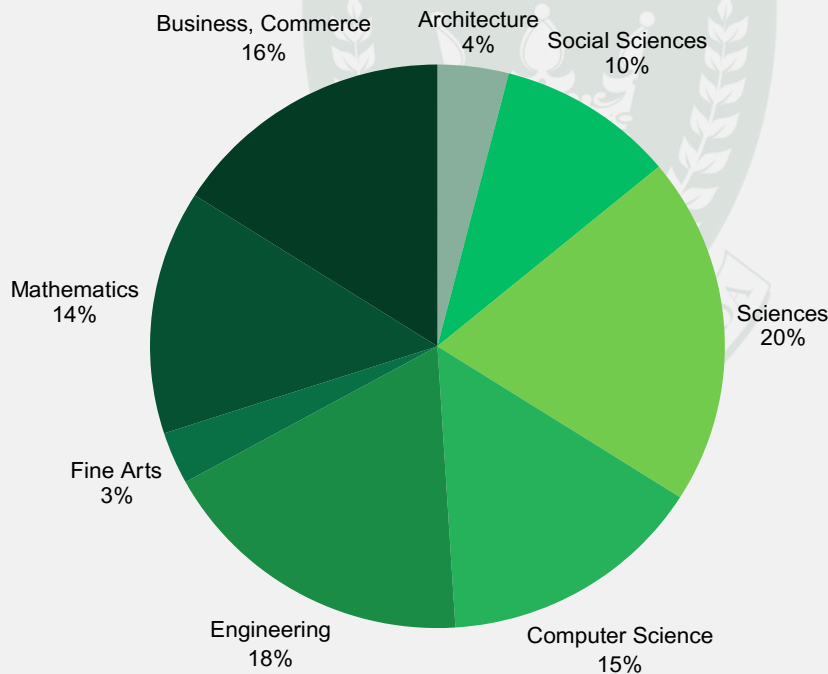

At William Academy, our support ensures students are confident, capable, and ready to thrive in school and beyond.



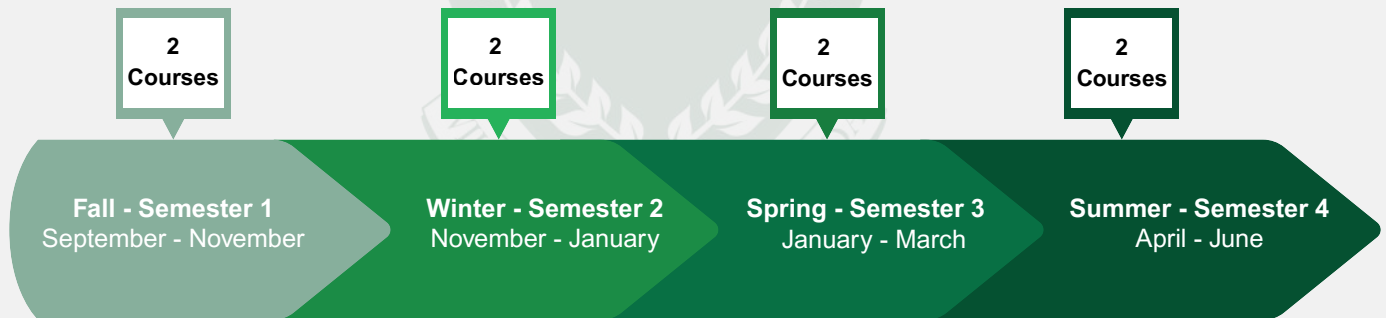
ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR AT A GLANCE

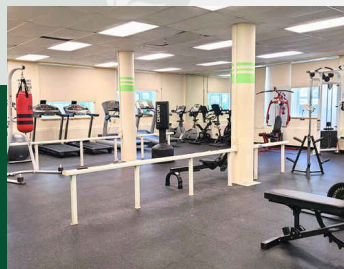
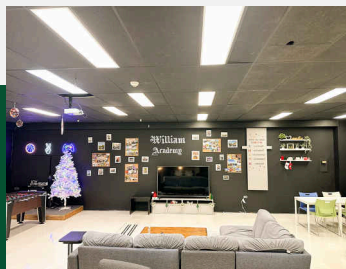

DORMITORIES

Volleyball

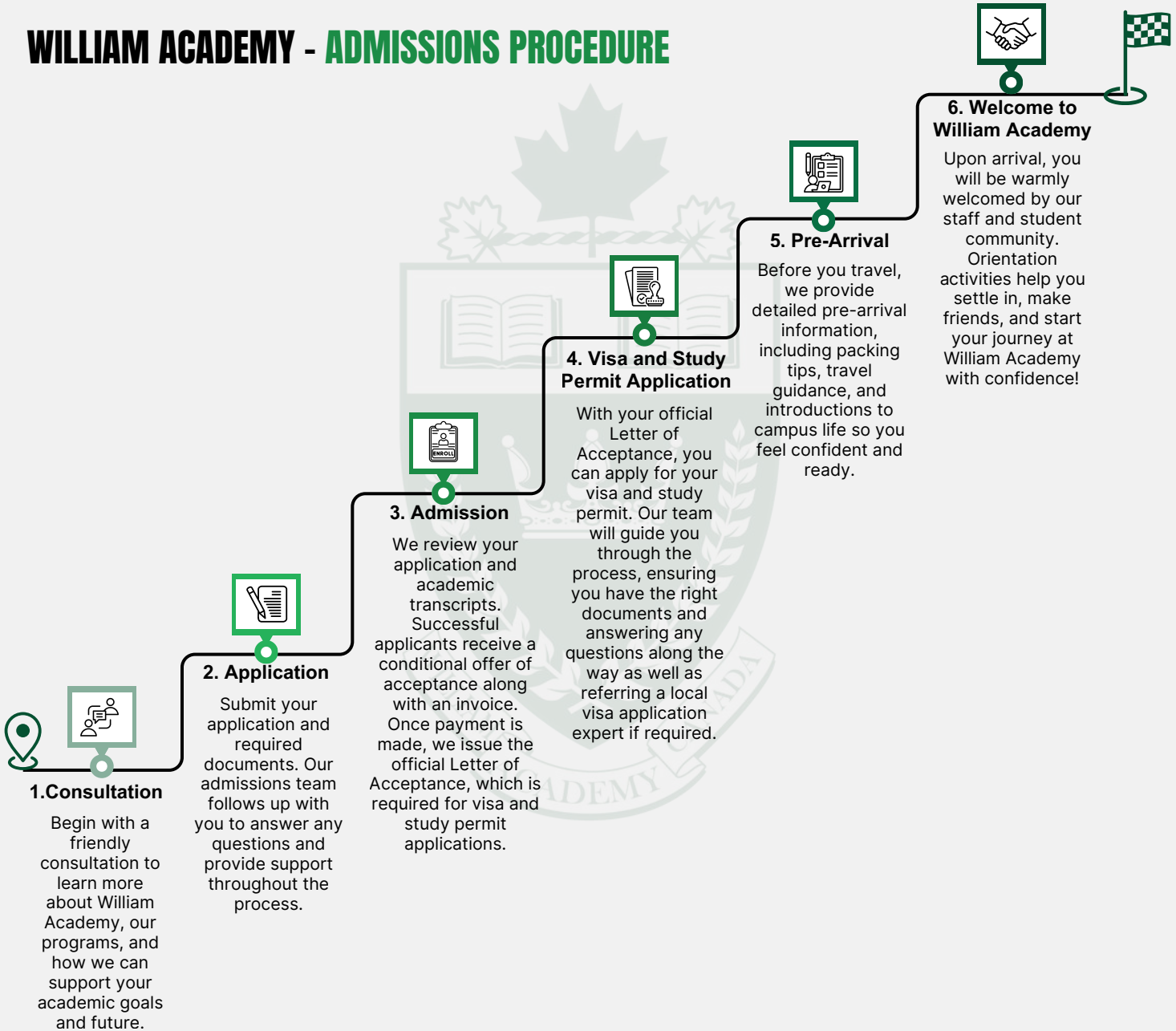

Cammy, Class of 2025 - McMaster University

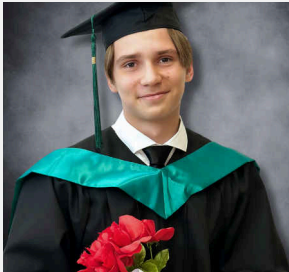

SHORT-TERM EXCHANGE

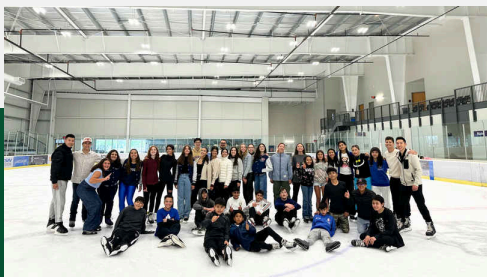
EXCHANGE AT WILLIAM ACADEMY

William Academy's Short-Term Exchange Programs give students the opportunity to **experience Canadian education and culture** without committing to a full academic year.
